

The program culminates in an Open House where startups have the ability to meet with investors, thought leaders, government, and other stakeholders to showcase their growth.









MENTORSHIP

The program also culminates with a pitch competition where the top scoring pitch is awarded a valuable prize package.

MinuteSkill is a social learning network for early-stage entrepreneurs.

"We had a phenomenal experience with Treefrog. Honestly, that really moved the dial for our business. It came at a point in our journey where MinuteSkill was more of an idea."

They "were asking thought-provoking questions that forced us to grow and evolve. There were many moments like that, but it started with that first conversation."





I think the reason why I wanted to bring one of my co-founders into the Treefrog Accelerator is to give us a little bit of structure to help us understand: what is the company? How does the company grow? How do you scale a company? and learning from the mentors.

I also thought the mastermind groups with [other] cohort members

and some lead mentors to kind of facilitate discussion in and around entrepreneurship brought a lot of value to me. It really helped me understand what other people were going through. It's not that different, even though the industries may be completely different, but the experience and the struggle are the same."
